History of United States foreign policy is a brief overview of major trends regarding the foreign policy of the United States from the American Revolution to the present. United Kingdom–United States relations, also referred to as British–American relations or Anglo-American relations, refers to the bilateral relations between the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.
