The Parthenon (/ ˈp ɜːr ˈ θ ɒ n ˌ n, -n ʔn /; Ancient Greek: ?????????; Greek: ??????????, Parthenónas) is a former temple on the Athenian Acropolis, Greece, dedicated to the goddess Athena, whom the people of Athens considered their patron. Description. The Magi are popularly referred to as wise men and kings. The word magi is the plural of Latin magus, borrowed from Greek ????? (magos), as used in the original Greek text of the Gospel of Matthew (in the plural: ?????, magoi).
