This ladybug math was a fun way for my kids to practice recognizing numbers and get some fine motor practice at the same time. 1. Write your letters on the stickers. I made sure each letter was on the same color, so as not to be confusing. We played with the lowercase letters in Big and Little Brother's names (8 pairs), but you could do anything...numbers, shapes, sight words, or colors!
