This helps to avoid damaging leaves while digging and makes it easier to pick up the hosta when you're ready. Another little noticed attribute of Hosta plantaginea is its ability to reflush new foliage during the summer months. While most hostas species send up all of their foliage in the spring months, H. plantaginea is one of the only species that will continue to produce new leaves all summer long.
