About biblical interpretation, a.k.a. hermeneutics: A vocation (from Latin *vocātiō*, meaning 'a call, summons') is an occupation to which a person is specially drawn or for which they are suited, trained, or qualified. Calvinism (also called the Reformed tradition, Reformed Christianity, Reformed Protestantism, or the Reformed faith) is a major branch of Protestantism that follows the theological tradition and forms of Christian practice set down by John Calvin and other Reformation-era theologians.
