Given that basic rate tax is 20%, this means that every £10 you give is worth £12.50 to the charity. Basic rate tax is automatically paid to the charity. Before you give donations to any charity, make sure you take all the necessary precautions to insure your money goes where you intended it to. This also helps to keep you safe from identity theft and fraud. Cash is the most common way of giving, accounting for more than half of all donations.
