Sociology is the study of society, patterns of social relationships, social interaction, and culture of everyday life. It is a social science that uses various methods of empirical investigation and critical analysis to develop a body of knowledge about social order, acceptance, and change or social evolution. The persuasiveness of Charles Mills' paper Racial Liberalism (2007) arises from the fact that it plays off one's pre-theoretic beliefs about the lacunae between the ideals of liberalism as a political philosophy and the practices of the modern liberal-democratic state. In the last decade 'sectoral systems of innovation' have emerged as a new approach in innovation studies. This article makes four contributions to the approach by addressing some open issues.
