Quia Web allows users to create and share online educational activities in dozens of subjects, including English.² Children have opportunities to expand their use and appreciation of printed language. Children's appreciation and understanding of the purposes and functions of written language are essential to their motivation for learning to read. 'Oral language leads the way to written language' (Wallach & Butler, 1994.) Reading is a language-based skill (Catts & Kamhi, 1986). The relationship between oral language and reading is reciprocal (Kamhi & Catts, 1989) with each influencing the other to varying degrees as children progress through school. Phonics and word study instruction provide an opportunity to teach children that there are systematic relationships between letters and sounds, that written words are composed of letter patterns that represent the sounds of spoken words, and that recognizing words quickly and accurately is a way of obtaining meaning from what is read.
